NOMINATION PERIOD

The Nomination Period begins Wednesday, October 2, 2024, and ends at 11:59 p.m. on Monday, October 21, 2024.

VACANT POSITIONS

Following the Nomination Period, elections will be held for the following positions, which become vacant as of December 31, 2024. There is 1 vacancy for each position, and each position will have a term of 3 years.

Elected by the Membership:

- President-Elect
 - Representative Assembly (RA) Delegate Positions:
 - Family Physicians
 - Delegate from District 6 (South of the Fraser)
 - Delegate from District 8 (East/West Kootenays)
 - Delegate who provides services to the First Nations Health Authority or in other Indigenous health contexts
 - Specialists
 - Delegate from District 9 (Skeena)
 - Delegate who provides services in a rural community within the scope of the Rural Subsidiary agreement
 - Delegate who provides services to the First Nations Health Authority or in other Indigenous health contexts

Elected by Representative Assembly Delegates only:

- Board Director at Large Specialist
- Audit and Finance Committee Member at Large
- Governance Committee Member at Large
- Nominating Committee Member at Large



NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations must be **complete**, and **submitted** by the nominee using the required form. Please ensure you have selected the correct position for which you wish to stand as a candidate.

All nominees and nominators must be Doctors of BC members in good standing in a category eligible to hold office and vote.

Nominators may be contacted to verify and confirm they consented to serving as nominators.

CAMPAIGN PROCESS

All candidates are required to run their campaign in compliance with the **Doctors of BC Election Policy**. The Policy ensures campaigns are run in a fair, open and courteous manner.

Pursuant to the Policy, candidates are **entitled to submit biographical information and a statement** in PDF format, not exceeding two pages, and with no embedded links or candidate endorsements. In addition to briefly identifying their philosophy on issues faced by Doctors of BC, candidates are encouraged to demonstrate how any relevant experience, and their knowledge, skills and abilities, align with the core duties and competencies of the position for which they are seeking to be elected.

Compliant campaign materials will be posted on the web. Materials must be submitted by email to <u>voting@doctorsofbc.ca</u> and **must be** received by 12:00 p.m. noon on Wednesday, October 23, 2024.
